

# Changes log



## Overview

This window shows one by one all modifications occurred in an event beginning at its creation up to its final version on screen.

It is accessed from the day and week planning window context menu which pops-up when right-clicking an event, and also from their main menu to show the list of deleted events.

Each line relates to an event change

Successive lines show only the changes in between them. Non-modified fields appear blank, except for first and last lines, in which all fields are shown with their full contents.

Events with a yellow background are non-confirmed events.

When the cursor hovers over any line, a small window pops-up to show the event full information.

Below there is the list of columns and its description:

User                      The user who performed the change

A                            Describes the action produced over the event, which can be:

- ● Event creation
- ● Modification
- ● Deletion

Action date                Date and time when the action described in the above line was performed.

Room                        Theory class location or aircraft registration plate.

Plate

Start                        Event start date and time.



End	Event end time.
S	The event status, which can be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• S Scheduled</li><li>• C Confirmed</li><li>• P Performed</li></ul>
Course	The event associated course.
Pilot	The event associated pilot.
Instructor Professor	The event associated instructor or professor.
C	This column shows the letter 'C' when the event is cancelled.
Flight	This column shows the internal flight number associated to the event after entering the flight data. Before the flight data is supplied, this column is empty.
ID	Flight identifier.
Orig	The flight origin airport
Dest	The flight destination airport
Exercise	The associated exercise alias.
Type	The flight type
Remarks	The even-associated remarks.
